

Born on June 12, 1929, in Frankfurt, Germany, Anne Frank lived in Amsterdam with her family during World War II. Fleeing Nazi <u>persecution</u> of Jews, the family went into hiding for two years; during this time, Frank wrote about her experiences and wishes. 
